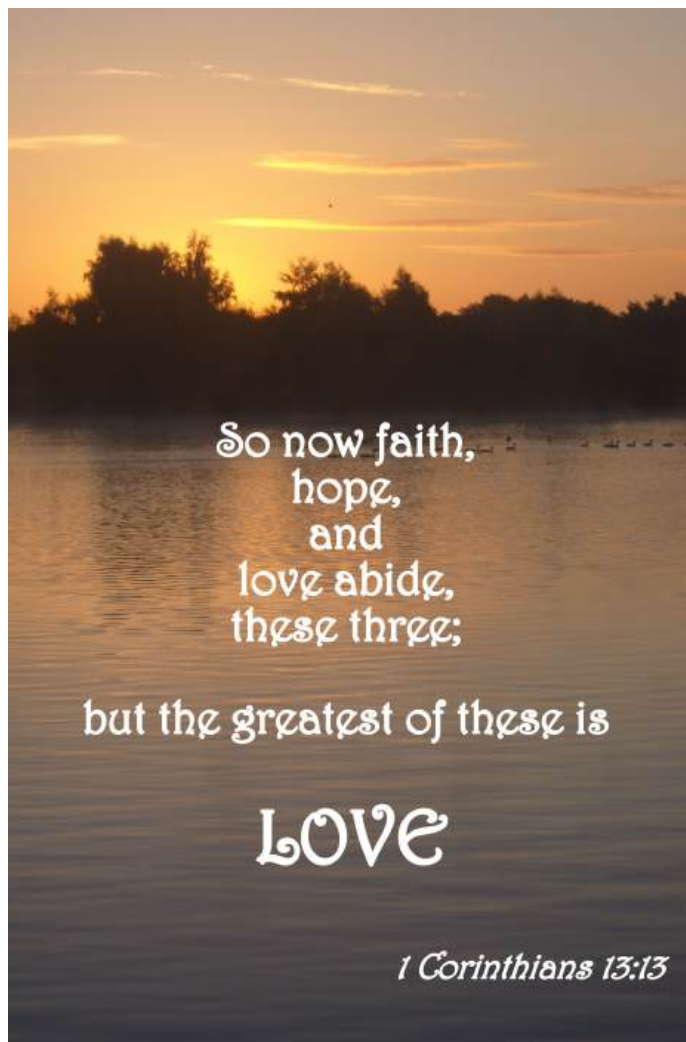

Our SOLC family program - FEET - brought in the new year 2026, by moving our feet and getting our blood pumping to a Praise Workout.

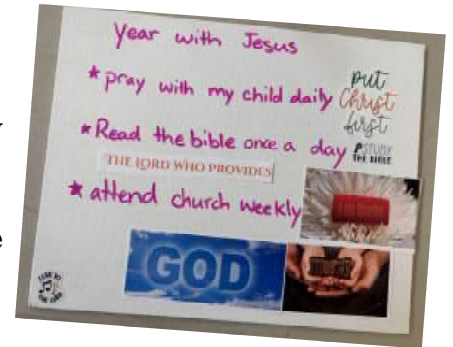
We enjoyed our most delicious Ethiopian lunch prepared by Eleni and Love Seyfu. Thank you!!!
